The platform includes gamification features and infographics that help trainees monitor their progress throughout the course. Administrators have the ability to import lists by school or teacher name in order to give participants remote access to the course. They can also monitor trainee progress.

The complete course consists of seven modules, and takes between six to eight hours to complete. Trainees go through the training lessons in sequence and have the option to go back to review earlier lessons.

The videos present and illustrate the tools and course content that DynEd teachers should know to implement the program. Short quizzes follow each video to confirm key points/information. These comprehensive video lessons also include hands-on assignments that require trainees to access and navigate the DynEd Records Manager and courseware to complete.
